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The Kaiapoi Community Board would like to see the trees remain in the Red Zone and the area grassed, maintained and left alone until we as a community have a better idea how much space will be available for projects. Prior to Government making any decisions and building expectations of projects within the Red Zone, Government need to identify who will be responsible for the care and upkeep of the area and how it will be funded. This is in addition to what funds Government will make available for development within the Red Zone. The Board want to see local firms or local non-profit organisations engaged to carry out all maintenance work in the Red Zone.

At this stage the Kaiapoi Community Board would like to see an area designated for self-contained motorhome use close to the town's retail precinct. The Board would also encourage a one way in/one way out road access be created in the Residential Red Zone (Cass Street, left into Meadow Street, right into Oram Place, left into Blackwell Crescent through to Gray Crescent) as this will help keep residents connected to the community.

As an interim measure the Board would like access retained to the boat ramp at Askeaton Drive pending Recreation Precinct consultation outcomes. This could be achieved by extending Charles Street or keeping Cass Street open.
